San Diego County Report Card on Children and Families
Supporting Document

Overview:

The 2013 San Diego County Report Card on Children and Families is a comprehensive report highlighting the health and well-being of children and youth in San Diego County. It reports not only on data trends, but also on effective practices and specific recommendations to “turn the curve” and accelerate progress on indicator trends.

The work of developing the 2013 Report Card was guided by a dynamic Leadership Advisory Committee comprised of national experts and local leaders in the fields of health, education, child care, child welfare, juvenile justice, and injury and violence prevention. For this 2013 Report Card, 25 indicators were selected to measure the health and well-being of children and families in San Diego County.

An important feature of the 2013 Report Card is the reporting of the current status of the indicators and the trends in the last few years as well as information on national best practices for prevention and intervention, and revised recommendations for action specific to San Diego County. This 2013 Report Card also provides updates on current local efforts and progress since the last Report Card in 2011.
