	2015-2020, which narrows and focuses the work of existing	
	programs to align with the decline in Prop 10 revenues. The new plan reduced KidSTART Center funding by 50%, which	
	has caused difficulties in the ability to provide adequate	
	services to children with complex needs. Adequate therapy, in	
	terms of frequency and duration is essential for children who have complex needs. The requested funding would provide	
	services for some of the most vulnerable children who would	
	otherwise not receive the services they need, thus addressing	
	a critical gap in service for this population.
