Executive Director Arguilez reported on the following with the Committee:

- The Committee received copies of the 2015 2020 Strategic Plan Summary Report for their review. The document is a synthesis and highlight report but, more importantly, is a call-to-action which will be presented to the Commission on April 20th 2021.
- The County will be receiving substantial monies from the American Rescue Plan (ARP). In anticipation of
 this, a local coalition of stakeholders are compiling a Memorandum of Recommendations to present to the
 Board of Supervisors which focuses on Child Care Recovery, Resilience, and Working Families. Some of
 the specific "asks" are reactivating the Emergency Child Care Vouchers and Child Care Provider Grants,
 but also addresses early childhood mental health needs, workforce pipeline support, childcare supply (as
 it relates to development and improvement) and County infrastructure.
- Congratulations to Finance Committee Vice-Chair Thompson on her recent, well-deserved promotion to HHSA CFO.
