### 8. Executive Director Report

Executive Director Arguilez reported on the following with the Committee:

- 1. Introduced Marcos Seide, a 2<sup>nd</sup> year graduate student at SDSU School of Social Work. First 5 San Diego has agreed to partner with SDSU Social Policy Institute's Director, Steven Hornberger, to work with Marcos on policy and legislation for one year as a volunteer intern.
- 2. F5SD has continued to hold the All Contractors' Meetings virtually with an increase in the attendance rate. This past June, there was a year-end reflection of this first year of our 5-year strategic plan.
- First 5 San Diego will be bringing an action item to the next commission meeting relating to a grant with First 5 California (F5CA). F5CA is looking for counties to form a <u>Shared Service Alliance</u> (entrepreneurialism and infrastructure support (ie. benefits negotiation, HR support, tech platforms, etc) to smaller scope childcare providers). The Shared <u>Service Alliance Pilot Grant</u> is \$250k over 2 years.
- 4. Shared a link to "An Open Letter from Economists and Public Policy Scholars in Support of Longterm Childcare Investment" which further validates the need for change within this 50-year old early care system.
- Marci Reyes has returned to the commission as Fiscal Manager. Tina Bagsic joined the Commission in December and has moved to a different section of HHSA; she always had the best attitude and was instrumental in creating our CAFR.
