Executive Director Arguilez updated the Committee on issues affecting the Commission including:

- We will be entering a new funding cycle for 2025-2030 and this will require feedback from the Commission and the Ad Hoc Committee for Strategic Planning.
- Continued Spend down of the fund balance is happening and due to anticipated decrease in revenue in the future, the Commission will focus on how and what it can fund.
- \$3M overall increase in funding HDS is to address the impacts on providers (inflation; increase in the number of referrals) and the system of care.
- Finance Committee member are invited to join the AdHoc Strategic Planning committee.
- Statewide advocacy efforts are continuing. ED Arguilez is the policy chair for First 5 Association and is looking at State and Federal solutions to our work.
- ED Arguilez has been working with HHSA to understand the new approaches around enhanced care management and community supports that are being paid for through Medi-Cal managed care plans.
- The partnership with the new Child and Family Wellbeing Department will include prevention and preservation funds through the FFPSA.
- Finance Committee member were encouraged to attend the Commission meeting in April.
