# Program Funding Reduction Overview

# Healthy Development Services (HDS)


FY 24-25	FY 25-26
\$12,700,000	\$12,700,000

- \$4.3M of the Tobacco Settlement Fund was allocated to the HDS program restoring funding for FY25-26.
- Restoration funding allowed providers to minimize impact to workforce by restoring FTE's and continue providing all levels of behavioral and developmental services.
- Providers are piloting new activities such as cross regional group services in an effort to reduce wait times and leverage workforce capacity.

# KidSTART Center

FY 24-25	FY 25-26
\$1,100,000	\$975,000


- Adjustments to targets were reduced as follows:
  - # children receiving KS Center Services (84 to 76)
  - # children receiving Care Coordination (200 to 180)



# Oral Health Initiative (OHI)

FY 24-25	FY 25-26
\$1,000,000	\$500,000

- All subcontractors were maintained for FY 25-26
- Targets were reduced from:
  - # of Screenings 10,155 to 7,180 (29.3% reduction)
  - # of Exams 8,710 to 6,435 (26.2% reduction)
  - # of Treatments 8,200 to 5,940 (27.6% reduction)
  - # of Care Coordination 3,877 to 2,340 (39.6% reduction)
  - # of Parent/Caregiver Education 2,965 to 1,925 (35.1% reduction)
- Impact to preventive services such as fluoride varnish to children 0-5.
- Treatment fund was reduced by 49%

# First 5 First Steps

FY 24-25	FY 25-26
\$8,528,655	\$6,249,265

- Received bridge funding (\$597,064) from CFWB to maintain continuity in services.
- Procurement for the HV program is active and new contracts pending.
- CalWORKs HV program was reduced by \$476,143.
- Target reductions will be reflected in new contracts issued.

# Learn Well Initiative

FY 24-25	FY 25-26
\$8,000,000	\$4,000,000

- SDCOE terminated several subcontracts
- Coaching model shifted from in-person 1:1 model to group coaching with 3 in-person/virtual sessions
- SDCOE staff reduction
- Provider stipends reduced
- Elimination of funding for Kindergarten transition materials
- Reduced other outreach materials provided to program participants:
  - Kindergarten Transition outreach materials.
  - Printing of resources
